No evening assembly at the building. Classes will still be online for now.

**The 8:30 AM Auditorium Assembly gives preference to those at an increased risk to COVID-19 infection.**



## What if I stay home?

A link to a video of the full Auditorium worship will be sent out via 151stnews email by 10 AM on Sunday.

Please do not attend if you **experience symptoms** of fever, cough, or symptoms related to COVID-19.

If you attended in recent weeks, we ask you continue to attend the same service time and location. If you will attend for the first time, please let us know in advance so we can ensure proper seating.



## What about distancing and masks?

We ask that everyone maintain distancing of 6ft between family groups.

**\*\* We strongly urge you to wear a mask if you choose to attend the Early Auditorium Worship at 8:30 AM. \*\***

Due to increased exposure while singing, wearing a mask is encouraged, but not required at other services.



## Where should I enter?

For Auditorium assembly, please enter through the east facing doors under the awning. Or if you are attending at the Fellowship Hall, enter through the south facing doors.

## Where and how should we sit?

In the Auditorium, every other pew is empty. Please refrain from climbing over people or pews as you move to the middle of each row.

In the Fellowship Hall, seats are arranged to accommodate family units in accordance with distancing guidelines.



## What about communion and contributions?

Communion supplies are available as you enter the building. Bags are provided to dispose of leftover communion supplies and trash.

A box for contributions will be available in addition to online giving options.



## What happens after we dismiss?

Please dismiss promptly at the end of services.

The parking lot is a great place to stick around and chat if you would like.

For the unattended nursery, follow signage to the designated areas.
